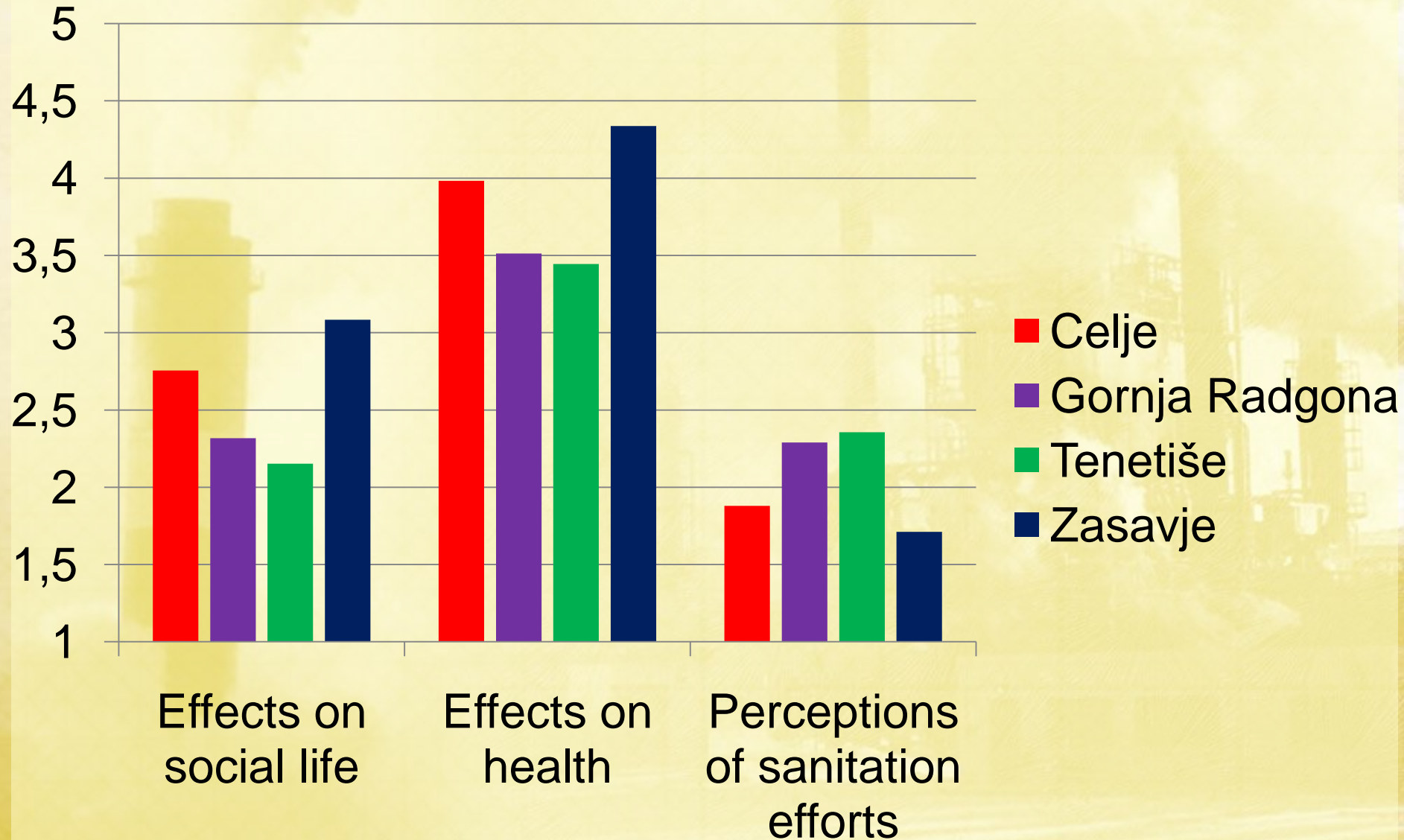
PREVIOUS RESEARCHES SHOW

- Mere conviction of risk is enough
- Chronic stress, feelings of insecurity
- Lack of trust in institutions responsible for environmental sanitation
- Anxiety and fear
- Aggression
- Diminished pro social behavior
- It is not clear how long-term living in polluted environment impact perceptions of pollution

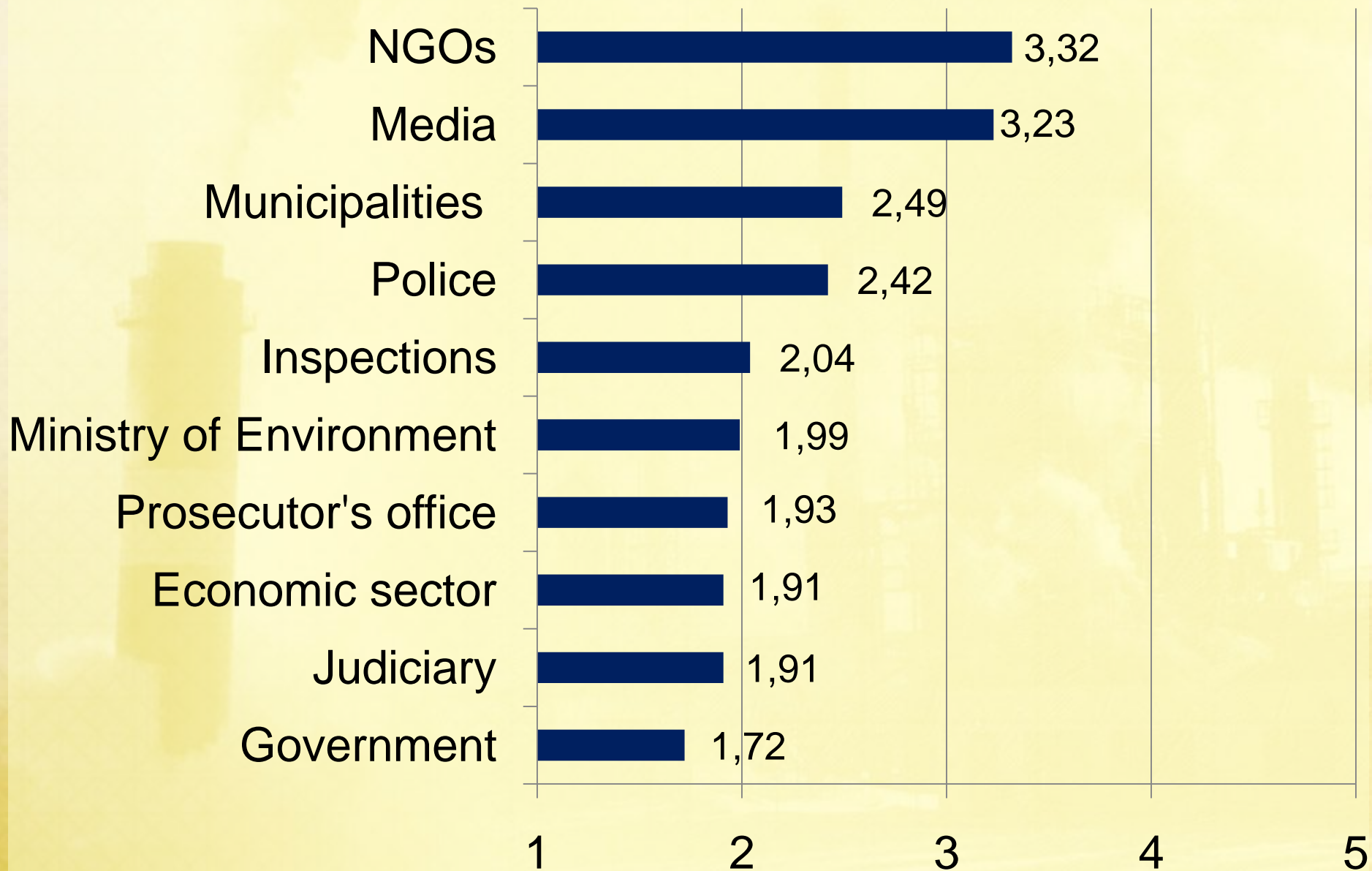

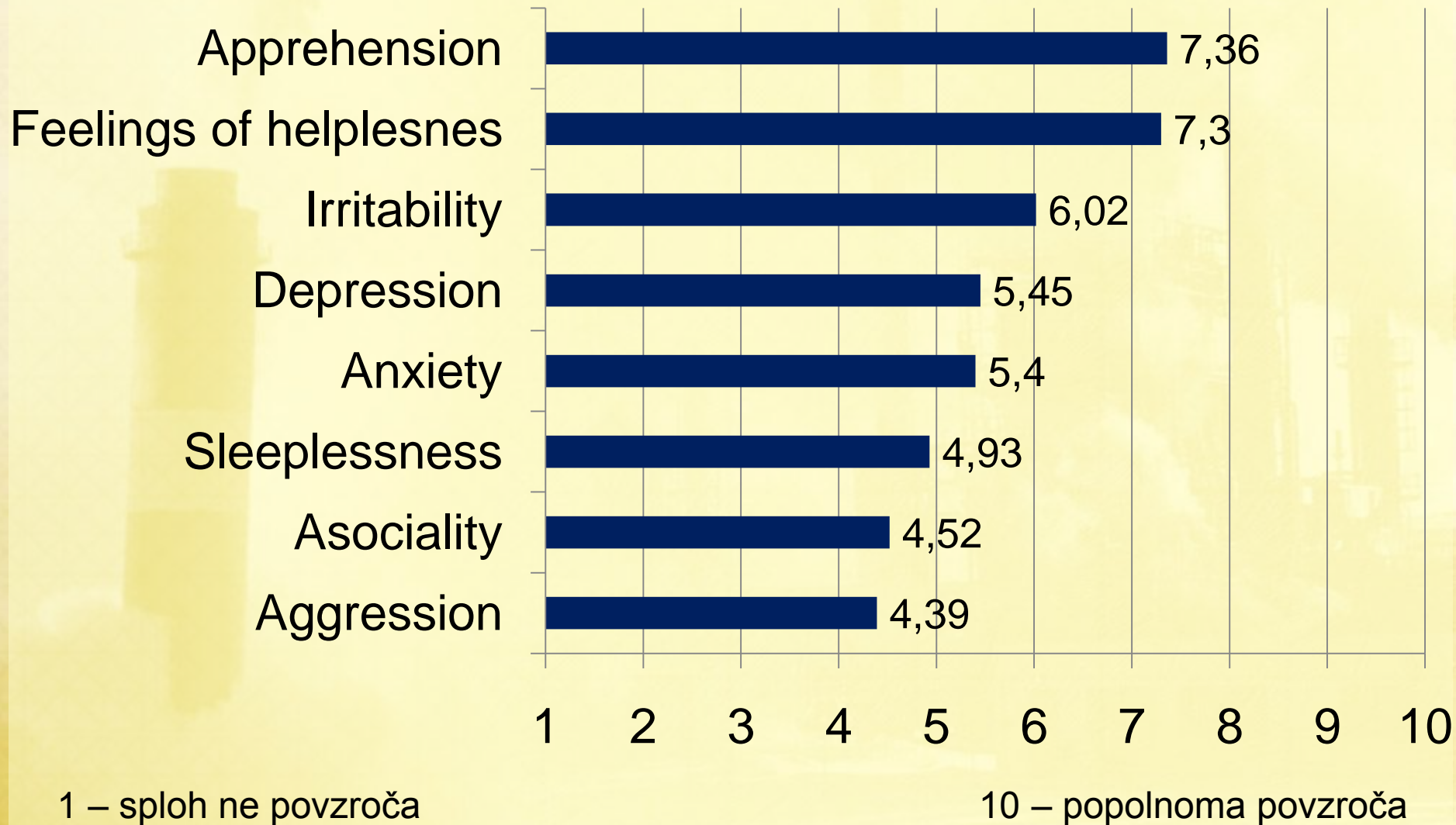

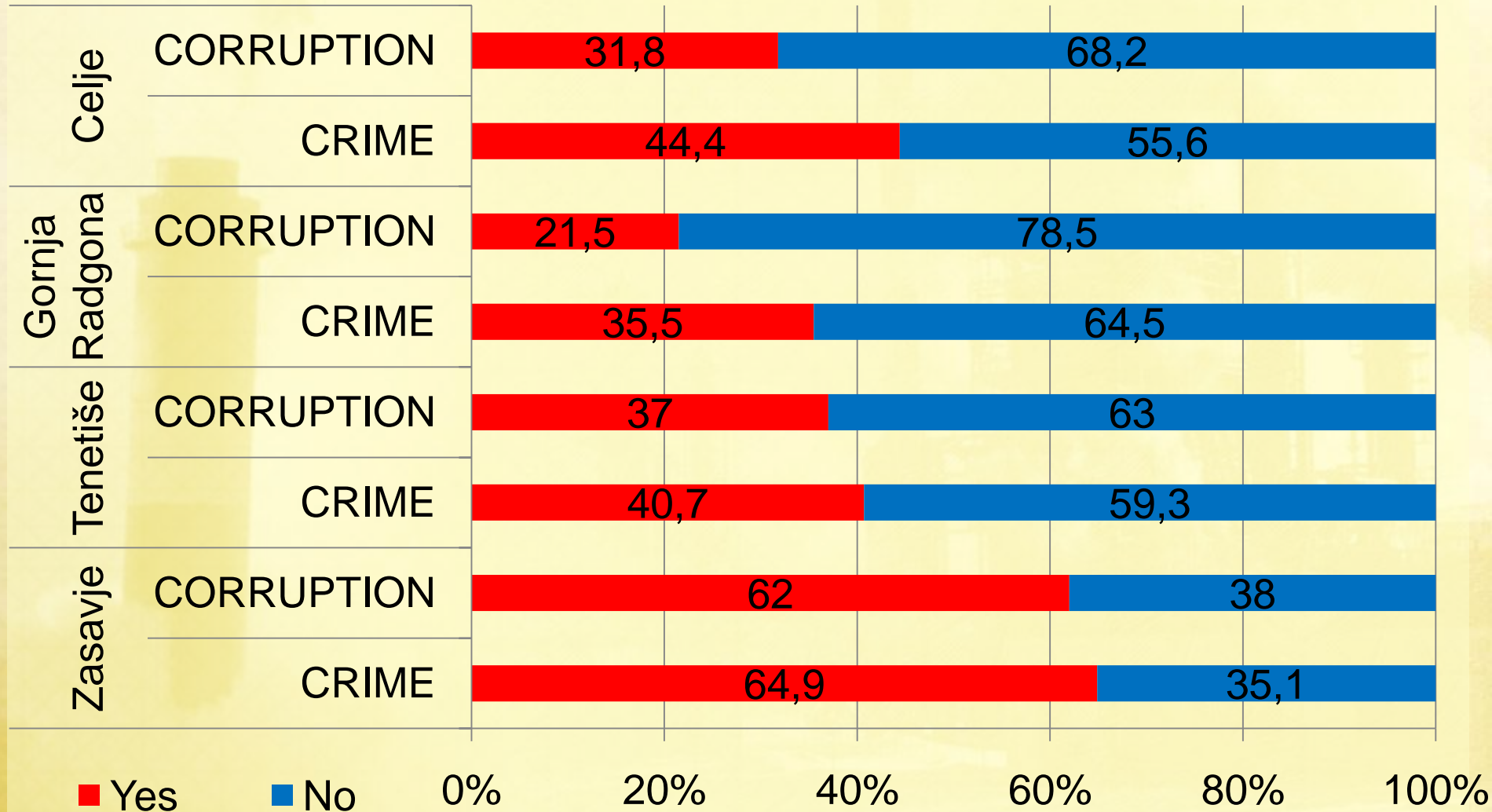
